

The position requires an earned master's degree or higher in physical education or a closely related field. Additional responsibilities include teaching upper- and lower-division courses in physical education activities, coaching theory, and general fitness beginning fall semester 2026.

The Bobcats are NAIA Division II National Champions (2006), with multiple Final Four appearances, and frequent 20-win seasons. With exceptional facilities, loyal community support, and alignment between athletics and institutional values, College of the Ozarks offers an incoming head coach the opportunity to lead a nationally competitive program while shaping young men for success on the court and in life.
